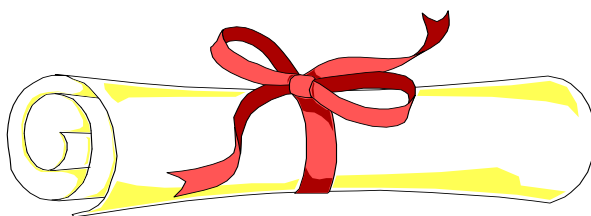
"Why Say No to Drugs", and the parent or guardian's certification by August 1st, 2010 to the Association office at:
