Marijuana Investigations

Marijuana is the most widely used and readily available drug in the United States. The use of hydroponics (growing plants in a nutrient laden solution rather than conventional soil) and other technological advances have enabled cultivators to increase the potency of THC, the psychoactive ingredient in marijuana plants. This course will cover indoor grows investigations, discussing Prop215 issues, SDG&E concerns, resources, and Toxic Exposure issues (mold). There will also be a mock grow set up where students will be shown what is of evidentiary value and the need for video taping.
