DESCRIPTION: Class will cover the First Responders Responsibilities, dangers of chemicals encountered, exposure risk and harm, chemical reactions and byproducts and applicable legal codes. How methamphetamine is made including Red Phosphorus and Anhydrous Ammonia methods, use, manufacturing and trafficking trends. There will be overviews of prior clan labs along with discussions of Drug Endangered Children protocols and investigations.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: All law enforcement officers, including Probation or Parole agents, DA Investigators, and military are welcome. If there is the remotest possibility that you may come into contact with an active or inactive lab, a boxed or stored lab, any of the of chemicals used to produce or byproducts from a cook, you should attend.

INSTRUCTORS: Sgt. Bob Camarillo is a thirty-year veteran of the Oxnard Police Department. He is assigned as a Team Supervisor for the Ventura County Combined Agencies Team (VCAT Narcotics Task Force) for the past six years and has 11+ years in narcotics investigations. He is a POST certified instructor in clandestine laboratory recognition for first responders, clandestine laboratory safety and annual certification, and drug endangered child investigations. He has been involved in the investigation, processing, and dismantling of thirty plus clandestine labs. Detective Bob Eckman is a fourteen-year veteran of the Oxnard Police Department. He has been assigned to the VCAT Narcotics Task Force for the past 6 years and has over 9 years experiences as a narcotics investigator. He is a POST certified instructor in clandestine laboratory recognition for first responders, clandestine lab safety and annual certification, and drug endangered child investigations. He has been involved in the investigation, processing and dismantling of over twenty clandestine labs.

LOCATION: Paso Robles Public Safety Center (PD) 900 Park Street, Paso Robles.
Directions: North US 101 exit Spring Street follow Spring Street to 10th Street / right on 10th Street the PD is one block and on right.
South US 101 exit 16th Street / (at stop sign) make a left on Riverside follow Riverside south to 10th Street / make a right on 10th Street / PD is one block west and on the left.
Entrance to the PSC is at the corner of 10th and Park Street . Best location for parking is in the area of 9th Street and on Park and Pine Streets
