**EMERGING DRUG TRENDS & NEW DRUGS OF ABUSE:**

CNOA and HIDTA are jointly hosting "Emerging Drug Trends & New Drugs of Abuse". With the increasing number of Substitute Drugs flooding the market and the spread of the use of non-traditional drugs, law enforcement is faced with the problem of enforcement. Many of these drugs, (**MDMA, DMT, DXM, Kratom, Salvia Divinorum, LSD substitutes, ect.**), are not covered in traditional drug training programs. This course will provide the student with the knowledge to identify the drugs, learn the common ways of usage, and the paraphernalia commonly associated with these drugs. Techniques for enforcement and the prosecution of violations stemming from use of the drugs will be discussed. This course will also discuss current trends in the club scene. **This unique class will be beneficial to all law enforcement officers regardless of assignment.**

**Instructor: Sergeant Troy Gielish, Irvine Police Department**

Sergeant Troy Gielish has had years of experience in investigations of narcotics and persons under the influence of drugs. He is a certified DRE and DAR instructor and is a staff instructor for CNOA in the areas of DAR and Standardized Field Sobriety Testing Programs. Sgt.
