INSTRUCTOR: Detective Ebrahim Ashabi is a 10 year veteran of long Beach Police department was born in Iran as Shiite Muslim. Ashabi lived through the Iranian Islamic Revolution 1978-79 and Iran – Iraq war. He fled from Iran in 1982 to Europe. After immigrating to the U.S. and living in New York and Washington D.C., he moved to Los Angeles and joined the Long Beach Police Department in 1997. Ashabi is assigned to Office of Counter Terrorism and is responsible for collecting, analyzing and investigating criminal intelligence related to international and domestic terrorism, organized crime, and extremist activity. He has been involved in training law enforcement for the past five years.

Directions: Traveling North on Hwy 101, take the Las Positas exit, continue through the traffic light and enter the show grounds on the right. If traveling South on Hwy 101, exit Las Positas, left onto the overpass, left at the traffic light, enter show grounds on the right.
