During his tenure he has worked in the Central Misdemeanor Unit for North and South Santa Clara County, the Santa Clara County DA's Office robbery unit, theft unit, assault unit, career criminal unit, sexual assault unit, narcotics and major narcotics unit. In 1995, Frank won the CNOA prosecutor of the year award. In 2003, Frank became the supervisor of the South Santa Clara County office which handles all the misdemeanor and felony cases in the south county. In January of 2009, Frank became the supervisor of the Santa Clara County DA's narcotics and major narcotics unit, the preliminary examinations of complaint unit, and the violation of probation unit.

Patrick Varnier has been a Deputy District Attorney for 10 years. The first 7 years of his career he was a Deputy DA with the Contra Costa County DA's Office where he worked in the narcotic prosecution office handling search & seizure and wire taps for 4 years. Patrick has been with the Santa Clara County DA's Office for the past 3 years where he worked in the sexual assault prosecution team. In January of 2009, Patrick was assigned to the Santa Clara County DA's narcotics unit; major vendor team.
