Instructor: **Special Agent Stephen Duncan** has been with the California Department of Justice for the past 14 years. Prior to his employment with DOJ, Agent Duncan was a probation officer for the San Diego County Probation Department for 12 years. During his 26 years in law enforcement, Agent Duncan has investigated street gangs, the Mexican Mafia prison gang and the AFO. For the past 18 years, Agent Duncan has investigated enforcement and drug distribution cells of the AFO that include members of the southern California street gangs and the Mexican Mafia prison gang.

Course : This workshop will provide a regional account of the Tijuana Cartel known as the Arellano-Felix Drug Trafficking Organization (AFO), regarded as one of the most violent drug cartels in Mexico. AFO enforcement, drug distribution, murder, kidnapping, public corruption and money laundering will be detailed as well as investigative strategies targeting the AFO. The rise in extortions, kidnappings and murders in San Diego, due to the ongoing battle between the AFO and other MDTO's, will be featured as well as ways to investigate, apprehend and prosecute these kidnappers and murderers. This unique class will be beneficial to all law enforcement officers regardless of assignments as well as those involved in P&P and criminal prosecutions. Recent arrests, extraditions and prosecutions of key AFO leaders will also be featured in this class.
