Basic Telecommunications Exploitation Program (BTEP)

The Class: The SOD Basic Telecommunications Exploitation Program employs multi-media technology and expert instruction to present methods of telecommunication device exploitation, the function and role of the Special Operations Division, investigative strategies, and DEA policy and procedures. Teaching points are presented to students in the form of actual DEA case scenarios and require a high degree of student participation. Throughout the three-day course, the students are given case related problems to solve and then are broken into groups of eight to ten individuals. During these "Break-Outs," students formulate investigative approaches, employ device exploitation techniques, and plan enforcement actions. The course has been designed to build upon teaching points from each of the prior modules of instruction. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that all students be required to attend every portion of the course.
